# EASIER ACCESS – PROGRAM WIDE

- 52 stations are currently accessible
- Committed to making the remaining stations accessible by 2025
- Working with the Advisory Committee on Accessible Transit on effective design
- Look for elevators, tactile strips and other features that will improve mobility for all transit riders

- Maximize customer convenience  
(shortest path from street level to subway platform and bus terminal)
- Maximize customer safety
- Minimize construction impacts




# Glencairn Station - rendering

Provides a barrier-free path to all levels of the station including installation of:

- Two elevators
- Improved signage and lighting
- CCTV security cameras
- Installation of tactile strips









# TTC COMMITMENT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Community Liaison to be single point of contact for the community
- Regular updates to individuals on the project mailing list
- Provide clear, accurate and timely construction information
- Post regular updates on a dedicated project page at [projects.ttc.ca](http://projects.ttc.ca)
- Maintain access to the station at all times
- Ensure contractor complies with local bylaws



# WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Increased presence of construction vehicles
- Dust and noise depending on stage of work, although most of the activity will be contained within the site
- Delivery of construction material and equipment (Primarily from Allen Road)
- Site office to be located in parkette north of Viewmont Ave
- Construction will typically occur between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. on weekdays, with some evening and weekend work when required
