Scope of work

Timeline: May to November 2023*

TTC will engage in the following activities:

- a) rehabilitate the concrete and asphalt pavement within the bus loop at Main Street Station,
 - b) rehabilitate the concrete bus platform, including tactile walking surface indicator, and
 - c) replace fencing throughout the loop.
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- Construction will be carried out sequentially to maintain pedestrian access to Main Street Station entrance.
 - Bus and Streetcar service will be relocated during the **loop closure from May 7, 2023 to September 1, 2023**.
 - Construction activities may continue to end of November.

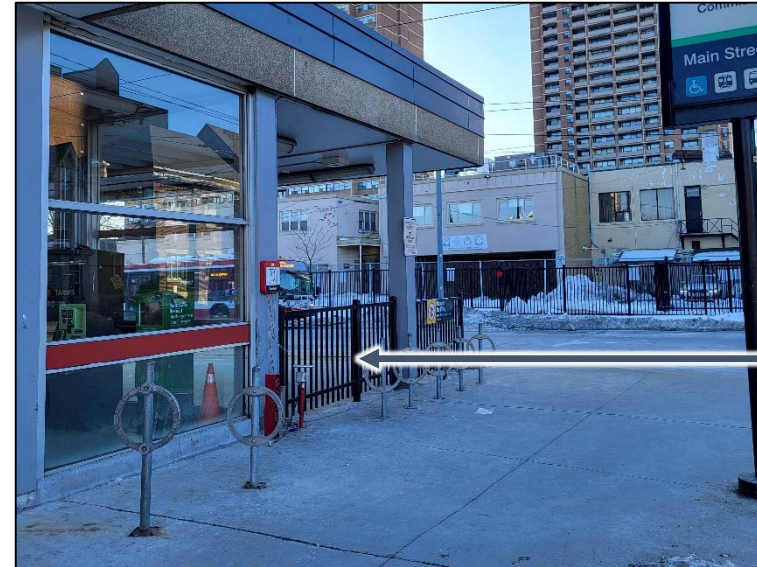

Previous work at Main Street Station

- From May to September 2018, Main Street Station bus/streetcar loop was closed for streetcar-specific infrastructure upgrades.
- 2023 Main Street Station project scope is limited to rehabilitation of bus loop pavement and bus platforms located on the south side of the station.

Construction Details

- Major construction activities include concrete and asphalt removal.
- Normal working hours shall be 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Monday to Friday. Work hours shall be 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Saturdays.
- Efforts will be made to keep disruption associated with noise and dust to a minimum.



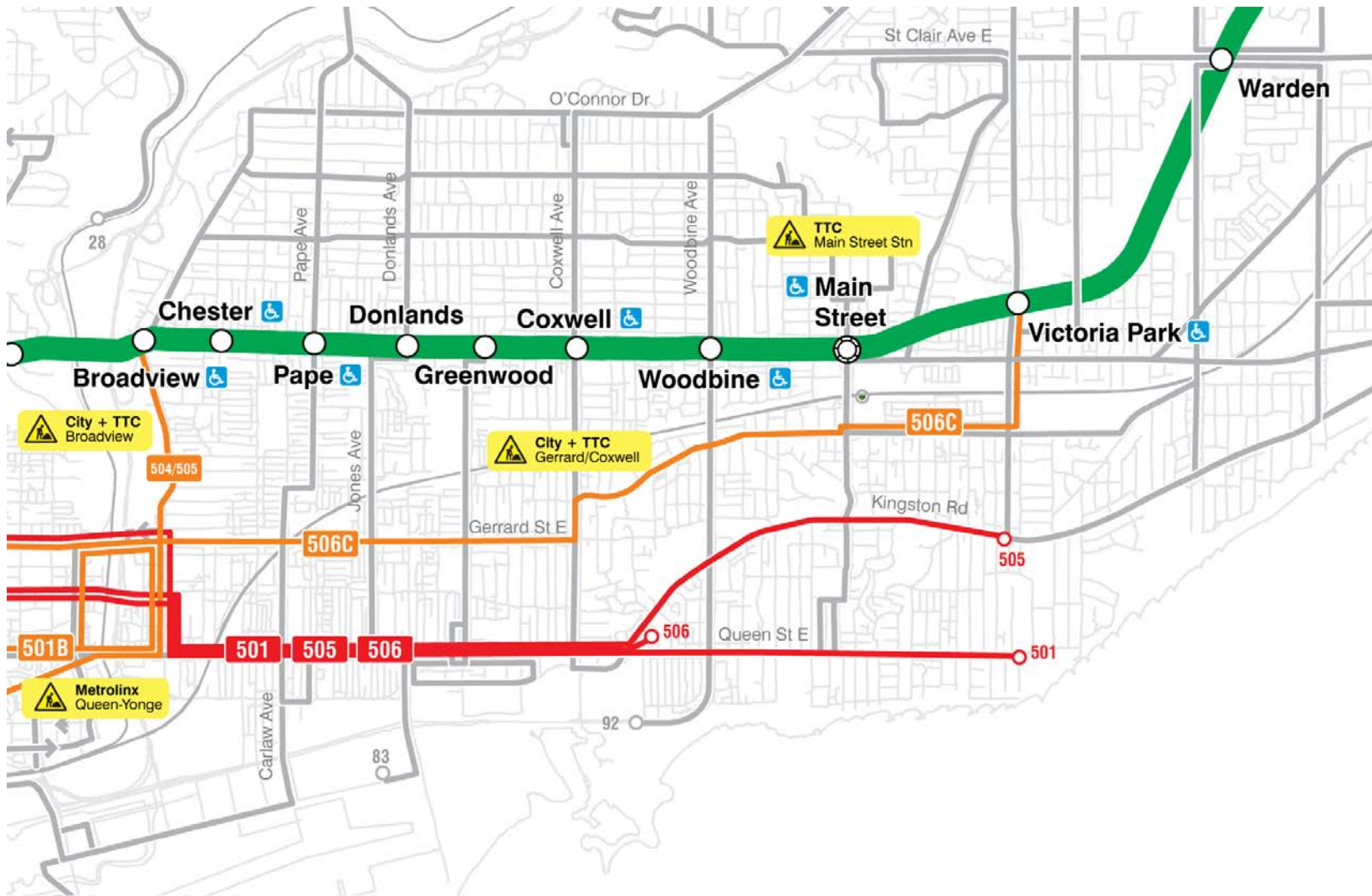
Service Impacts: Bus

- May 7, 2023 to September 1, 2023
- **23 Dawes, 62 Mortimer, 64 Main, 87 Cosburn, 113 Danforth, 135 Gerrard** will continue to serve Main Street Station. Temporary stops will be located on-street.
- **20 Cliffside** will be shortened to Victoria Park Station.
- **62 Mortimer** will be extended to Victoria Park Station.

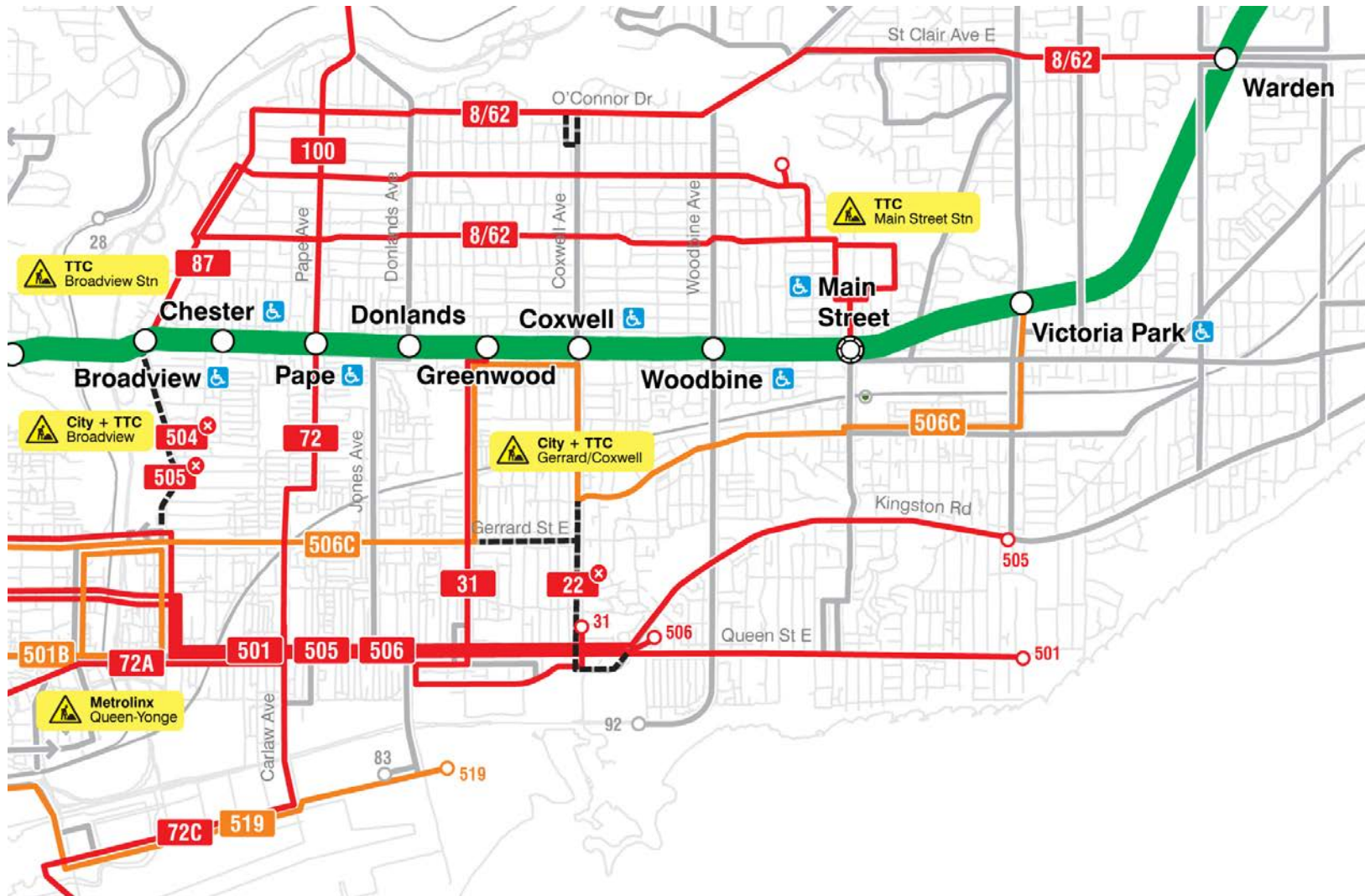

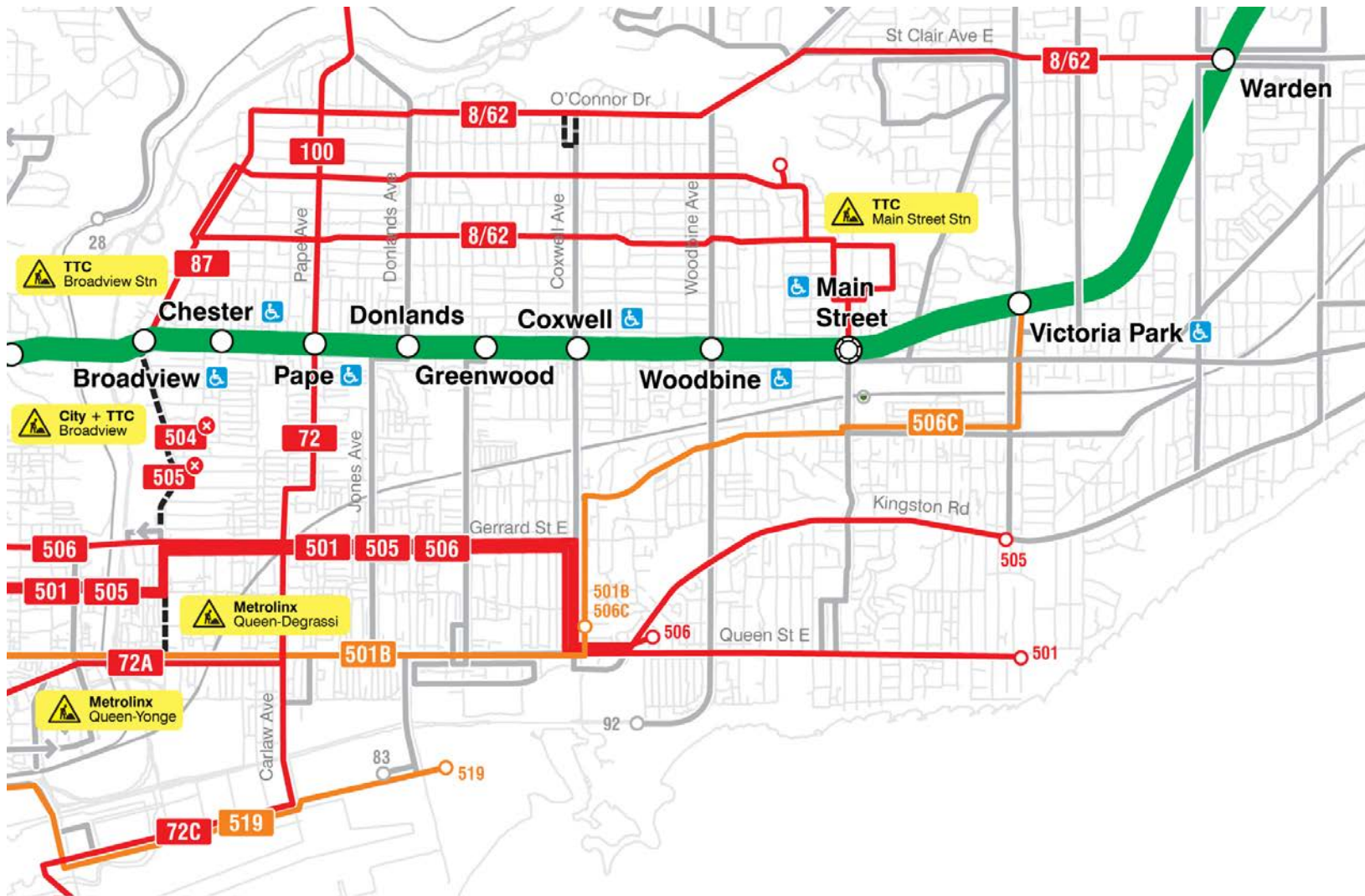

Streetcars divert to Kingston Rd/Queen St E. via Gerrard St E.

506C Carlton

Buses connect from Coxwell/Queen St E to Victoria Park Station.

64 Main southbound and **135 Gerrard** eastbound will continue to connect Main Street Station to Gerrard St E/Main St.

Traffic management

- Alleyways located at the north and south property lines of the Station will be in full operation.
 - The contractor *may* obtain ROW permit for temporary lane closures.
- Signage and flag persons for construction vehicles will minimize traffic disruption on adjacent streets.

Coordinating nearby work

- The City plans to upgrade the streetscape of the sidewalk adjacent to the south property line of Main Street Station – summer 2023.
- The City will build an eastbound dedicated right turn lane on Danforth Avenue at the intersection of Danforth and Main – late spring/early summer 2023.
