Lawrence Station – Easier Access Project Elevator construction starting this summer

Timeline: Starting Summer 2022

What we are doing and why

The TTC is making stations accessible as part of the Easier Access program. This program includes the installation of elevators, accessible doors, and updated wayfinding signage to create a barrier-free path from street level to the subway platform. Work is scheduled to begin this summer and be completed by 2024.

The Easier Access improvements will include:

- Two new elevators which will connect customers from the station entrance to the bus terminal and subway levels.
- New stairs from platform to concourse level of the station.
- Improved wayfinding and signage throughout the station.
- Accessible sliding doors at the main entrance, and barrier free doors throughout station.

Expected work activities

The first major phase of work will include shoring and excavation activities for the new elevator shafts, located near the existing station entrance beginning in fall 2022. Construction of all easy access improvements will be completed in Q4 2024.

Traffic, pedestrian and cyclist details

- Some restrictions will be required to safely complete the work:
 - Main entrances at the south end of Lawrence Station to be closed for eight months beginning in September 2023. Customers will be asked to use the Ranleigh Avenue, and Bedford Park Avenue entrances.
- Lawrence Station will be closed for three weekends in 2022. Shuttle buses will be deployed at street level during these closures, and a notice will be posted within the station in advance of impacted service.
- Night work is required on driveway at 3080 Yonge Street, two nights per week for debris removal and material delivery from vent shaft.

Work hours

Work will take place Monday to Friday between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. Some work on Saturdays between 9 a.m. and 7 p.m. may be required to maintain schedule.

TTC service

Access to the station, bus and subway service will be maintained throughout construction.
